

NEDERLAND NOXIOUS WEED MANAGEMENT

Noxious weeds are non-native plants that displace native vegetation, disrupt hydrologic processes, alter soil chemistry, and disturb the native ecosystem stability and diversity, while negatively affecting environmental and recreational resources. Pursuant to the Colorado Noxious Weed Act and Nederland Municipal Code, it is the duty of all persons to be educated and vigilant about controlling noxious weeds on their property. Reseeding disturbed areas with high-altitude certified weed-free native species is encouraged.


Disposal: Please bag up noxious weeds and dispose in commercial landfill. Alternatively, noxious weeds may be placed in compostable bags and brought to the Community Forestry Sort Yard, 291 Ridge Road, **free of charge**.
