PROSAB met on March 21st. We interviewed prospective member Baird Moorish (appointed by the BOT on April 2nd) and discussed possible areas of focus from the newly-approved PROST plan, wildfire mitigation plans, noxious weed strategies and the trails master plan process. A special meeting to discuss draft narrative language for the trails plan was held April 11th, and the next regular PROSAB meeting will be April 18th.

PROSAB currently has one vacancy.

IMA: The Intermountain Alliance met in Gold Hill on March 20th. Several representatives from Boulder County were on hand to discuss the County's strategic planning efforts around fuels reduction and the various County wildfire mitigation programs. Garry Sanfacon introduced the Regional Mountain Trails Planning Partnership and the Regional Sport Shooting Collaborative which is just getting underway. The next IMA meeting will be April 24th at 10:00 am in Ward.

Big Springs Emergency Egress: the Forest Service just informed us that we will have to pay for any time their specialists devote to establishing the egress road (this had not been mentioned in the several meetings we had had with them to discuss this project). The County is waiting for the snow to melt before continuing its work.

Firewise USA Communities: The Firewise action committee will meet soon to discuss a draft action plan.

Economic Development Task Force: This will get underway soon, as the Comp. Plan update process winds down.
