Saws & Slaws: Saws & Slaws sponsored an all-day chain saw training class on May 25th, followed by a day of cutting at the water plan site. This year, all sawyers at S&S events are required to have attended a training class. The first local event took place in St. Antons on June 8th with 38 participants. At least four events are scheduled for Big Springs this summer, with the first on June 29th on Barker Road. Big Springs Emergency Egress: We are still waiting on the County to evaluate our preferred route but expect this to happen soon. Once the route is determined, the next step will be to submit a proposal to the Forest service.

Firewise USA Communities: The Town's application for recognition as a Firewise Community has been submitted to Firewise USA for approval by CFS representative Allen Owen. Congratulations to Lake of the Pines HOA, which slipped in ahead of us to become the first Boulder County Firewise Community.
