**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF NEDERLAND ACKNOWLEDGING THE LOCAL EMERGENCY SERVICES RESPONSE TO THE RECENT EVENTS OF DECEMBER 30, 2008**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Nederland Board of Trustees wishes to commend the local public safety agencies and community members for their prompt, professional, and compassionate response to the tragic incident that occurred at Eldora Ski Resort on Tuesday, December 30, 2008; and,

**WHEREAS**, those who are to be commended include the Boulder Sheriff's Department, the Nederland Police Department, the Nederland Fire Protection District, the Boulder County Victim's Advocates, the personnel at Eldora Mountain, and the citizens who witnessed and reported the incidents; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Community suffered the loss of one of our own due to this tragedy; and,

**WHEREAS**, Boulder County Sheriff Deputy John Seifert is recognized for his heroism, courage and perseverance that saved further loss of life that day, including his own, and for his continued humanitarianism and support of the victim's family and the community at large; and,
