**RESOLUTION 2011 - 08**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEDERLAND BOARD OF TRUSTEES ADOPTING THE  
TOWN OF NEDERLAND ADOPT-A-PARK PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Part 3 of Article 25 of Title 31, C.R.S., the Town of Nederland (“Town”) possesses the authority to maintain and preserve, for public use and enjoyment, parks and recreational facilities and areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town currently maintains a variety of such facilities, including parks, open space areas, trails, and recreational facilities such as a skate park, ice rink and community center (collectively, the “Parks and Recreation Facilities”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of Trustees (“Board”) finds and determines that it is a worthy goal to promote public stewardship of Parks and Recreation Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Advisory Board (PROSAB) has developed and recommended to the Board an Adopt-A-Park program under which volunteers may adopt a particular Parks and Recreation Facility and be involved in such facility’s general care and maintenance for a year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board further finds that the Adopt-A-Program recommended by PROSAB is likely to be an effective means of encouraging and facilitating public involvement in the care of Parks and Recreation Facilities, to the benefit of the Town and citizens alike; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board therefore wishes to formally adopt the Town of Nederland Adopt-A-Park program, as further described by this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
THE TOWN OF NEDERLAND, COLORADO:**

Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby adopts the Town of Nederland Adopt-A-Park Program (“Program”). The mission of the Program is to protect and enhance Nederland’s parks, trails, and open space through ongoing volunteer support and special projects. Major features of the program shall include:

- The Program shall permit individuals and/or groups to adopt specific Town Parks and Recreational Facilities, or portions thereof, for one year renewable terms. During their terms, volunteers will assist in the general care and maintenance of their adopted Parks and Recreation facilities and perform special projects as suggested and approved. At the end of a term, volunteers may renew, change facilities (if available) or terminate their involvement in the Program.

- The Town shall place a sign in an adopted Park and Recreation Facility recognizing the person(s) or groups adopting such facility.
- The Town shall provide training, as needed, to volunteers and/or their designated leaders. Training topics may include beetle-kill identification, noxious weed identification and procedures for reporting issues of concern to the Town. No amount of training provided by the Town shall render adopting groups or persons anything but volunteers. No employment or agency relationship shall be created by the Program.

Section 2. The Town Administrator, or his or her designee, is hereby authorized to promulgate all application materials, forms, facility inventories, maintenance checklists and any other administrative documents and procedures necessary to fully implement the mission, goals and purpose of the Program.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
