Re: Staff Report – Police Department

The month of November showed a significant slowing in calls for service in town. Here is a quick synopsis of what we have been up to at the PD.

Here are a few notable calls for service we experienced:

- One Domestic Violence call that resulted in an arrest.
- Two separate disturbances originating from the Pioneer Inn. One resulted in an arrest.
- One break-in of an automobile where the suspect stole \$300.00 worth of Eldora Ski Resort clothing.
- A few roommate disputes.
- A phone harassment complaint from a frequent offender.
- One foot pursuit resulting in minor injuries to the officer; the suspect was apprehended.
- One reported case of child abuse.
- A reported assault with a knife that originated in the West Magnolia camping area on Thanksgiving. The victim waited several hours to report and then was not overly cooperative with a description. We have no reason to believe any of the Nederland citizens are at risk.
- Theft from a local business. It appears one of the employees helped themselves to the cash drawer.
- Several weather-related crashes or slide-offs in and out of town.

Officer Manzione attended Taser training and is now a certified instructor. Officers Smith and Geiger are attending combat emergency medical training.

All NPD Officers have stepped up to fill holes in the schedule as much as possible during this time when we are short-handed. I am contracting out with the Boulder County Sheriff's Office as little as possible to fill in the schedule.

I encourage town residents and employees to call the police when they see a problem. I have found it's easier to handle problems on the spot than to follow up days later.
