Re: Staff Report – Police Department

- During the reporting period, NPD staff conducted a community meeting in Old Town regarding a neighborhood dispute. The meeting was organized and hosted by community members, and NPD helped in identifying a proper resolution to the neighborhood dispute. This assistance has opened dialogue to create some form of neighborhood group to help others with similar issues.
- NPD finalized negotiations with City of Boulder to acquire three (3) Police Services Chevrolet Tahoes for the Police Department to replace an aging fleet. BOT subsequently approved the purchase. NPD logos and radio equipment are being scheduled to be installed. The Town of Nederland will send out an educational press release to inform the community of these new police vehicles and their purpose.
- NPD staff has continued to grow and develop beneficial region law enforcement relationships by conducting meetings with the Boulder City Police Department, Boulder County Sheriff's Department, Boulder County Coroner's Office, Boulder County District Attorney's Office, Ward Town Marshal and others.
- 30-Day Update: Interim Chief of Police Paul Carrill has been with the NPD for approximately 5 weeks. During this time, Chief Carrill has had opportunities to observe the day-to-day operations of the Police Department. These observations include, but are not limited to: the Department's computer system, fleet, basic police equipment, operating budget, administrative functions, operational functions, and meeting the community. Chief Carrill will provide a complete audit and inventory of the Nederland Police Department at the conclusion of Chief Carrill's interim period.

POLICE INFORMATION:

- On the evening of August 25, 2014, NPD responded to party down / non-breather call inside Dam Liquors. Nederland Fire / EMS also responded and attempted to resuscitate the party with negative results. NPD subsequently secured the crime scene and coordinated its investigation with the Boulder County Coroner's Office Investigator. The investigation is continued, pending autopsy report.
- The Nederland Police Department will again be participating in the Ninth National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day for Saturday, September 27, 2014. This initiative provides an opportunity for the public to turn in their accumulated prescription medications to law enforcement officers for proper disposal. The Nederland Police Department will be providing personnel and storage to accept prescription medications for proper disposal. The Nederland Police Department will work with the DEA for the proper disposal of the collected drugs.
