Background: The View program at the Teen Center wishes to construct a graffiti wall on the Teen Center grounds. They were directed by the BOT to work out details with Town staff, and the latter has referred them to various Town advisory boards for input. View Coordinator Lara Ruggles, along with View members Emma Quarterman, Danielle Bayer, Dan Kennedy, and Hannah Tuton will be attending to present the proposal, which is attached.

Background: In 2011, PROSAB reached out to TEENS, Inc. with the idea of collaborating on a noxious weed program in 2012. We talked about possibly holding one or more weed identification workshops, followed by community weed pulls. TEENS, Inc. has sponsored community weed pulls in past years, but participation fell until they discontinued the program. TEENS, Inc. receives annual grant funding for a weed program.
