Re: Staff report – Community Center

The Community Center is enjoying the annual summer lull in activity to re-group. The Mountain Forum for Peace sale was successful and popular as always. Donations seemed to be at a record high.

An Insurance Preparedness Workshop focusing on mountain homeowners will be held at the CC on Thursday, July 25. It will be hosted by Boulder County and Foothills United Way. The Nederland Area Seniors will hold a Pancake Breakfast from 8-11am on Saturday, July 27, as part of the Old Timers Days celebration. The Community Center is continuing to promote Pickle Ball throughout the month of July by offering free drop-in for the activity. See our ad in the Mountain Neighbor online.

July's largest activity at the Community Center is the Shred-a-thon on Saturday, July 20 from 9am-1pm. It is sponsored by our Police Department to raise money for Nederland's own Crime Stoppers program while promoting the effort to prevent identity theft.

The Fitness Place has provided a 3-punch pass to be included in Boulder Valley School District's coupon book for all BVSD employees who sign up for the district's EcoPass program.
