Re: Staff Report – Police Department

December and early January have brought us plenty of wind and a few noteworthy items to report.

- Traffic accident in which a local driver failed to provide information, and was later found to have a revoked driver's license for DUI.
- Child abuse case that was turned over to Health and Human Services.
- Two incidents related to domestic violence and violation of protection orders, both resulting in an arrest.
- An altercation over an intoxicated female at a local bar. This resulted in the female's boyfriend assaulting another female and busting the front window at a business on First Street. The suspect was arrested for Felony Assault and Criminal Mischief.
- A DUI crash at the Post Office. The victim physically held the suspect until Police arrived. The suspect was released from the jail and, within two days, had been involved in another DUI crash in Summit County.
- Burglary at Ace Hardware, resulting in two busted front doors, and theft of a .22 caliber pellet rifle valued at \$300.00. One possible suspect had been cleared.
- Arrest warrant attempt in Old Town for a juvenile female and her adult boyfriend. Both had warrants for Felony Burglary. The felony warrant was

arrested in Boulder a couple days later. This was achieved by good communication between Nederland and Boulder Police Departments, and the Probation Department.

- A couple shoplifters, theft from two vehicles and the other general stuff, medicals, welfare checks, crashes etc.

Officers Manzione attended Taser instructor training. Officers Johns, Smith and Geiger all recertified on DUI training.
