



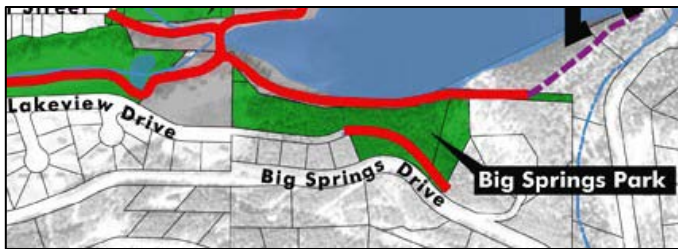

SAWS & SLAWS GROUP TO SEEK COUNTY CHIPPING GRANT

Once more, in partnership with the local Saws & Slaws forestry health program, the Town will apply for Boulder County chipping reimbursement funding this year. The past two years, the Town has applied for the funds to support curb-side and neighborhood-based slash collection and chipping efforts. The Town is supporting the Saws & Slaws model of private property mitigation. To learn more, visit:

Additionally, the Town is coordinating large-scale mitigation efforts for Town-owned or leased property, including the 3.5-acre Big Springs Park (east of Chipeta Park) and the Water Treatment Plant site. These efforts will leverage work from Mountain Youth Corps and
