PROSAB: PROSAB last met on June 20th. Members interviewed a candidate for a board vacancy and voted to recommend two candidates for appointment; reviewed a proposal by some local residents for horseshoe pits at Chipeta Park and voted to recommend that the project go forward with Town support; discussed current and upcoming area Forest Service fuels reduction projects with Boulder District Ranger Sylvia Clark; approved forms for gathering public input for naming the gateway park and to inform the trails master plan update; reviewed and offered feedback on the comprehensive plan update.

As of this writing, the agenda is not yet set for the upcoming meeting on July 18th, but is apt to include additional applicant interviews for the remaining vacancy, discussion of the upcoming Tungsten fuels reduction project with FS representative Cody Hutchinson, selection of finalists from the gateway park name suggestions received from the public and discussion of a recommendation to Boulder County Parks and Open Space regarding the future of the social bike trail that crosses the newly-acquired Sherwood property.

Saws & Slaws: The first Saws & Slaws neighborhood event of the season was held in Big Springs on June 20th with over 30 participants. (Thanks to Jim and Alisha Reis for hosting the event). Four more events, all in Big Springs, are scheduled for this year, and the number of interested property owners has nearly doubled in the last few weeks. The NFPD is donating a first aid kit to the Town for Saws & Slaws events.
