30 Minute Delays and 2-hour Highway Closures Expected Week of April 14

Monday, April 14 through Friday, April 19, sections of State Highway 119 - Boulder Canyon will have single lane closures and full highway closures. During working hours up to 3 areas will be impacted concurrently.

A single lane closure will remain in place near MP 39, 24-hrs a day, 7-days a week to preserve the work zone. Traffic will be managed by a timed traffic signal.

Work on several drainage culverts along the highway will continue throughout the week, Monday- Friday, between MP 27-30 and MP 30-33. The locations of the culvert crews will change throughout the day. Motorists will be guided around the single lane closure with traffic control flaggers.

Full Highway Closures

Beginning Wednesday, April 17, through Friday, April 19, rock blasting activities will result in a full closure of CO119 at MP 39-41; for 2 hours at a time, between the hours of 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and again from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

Work hours for this week are 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. 30 minute delays are expected through the canyon during work hours. Speed limits are reduced to 25 miles per hour in the construction zones. The work is weather dependent and the schedule may change. Please plan additional time to travel through the construction zones or to use alternate routes. See the attached map for the alternate route.

Trail Closure

The Boulder Canyon Trail, from Boulder Canyon trail head to the Fourmile Canyon trail head will be closed Wednesday – Friday 7 a.m. – 3 p.m.
